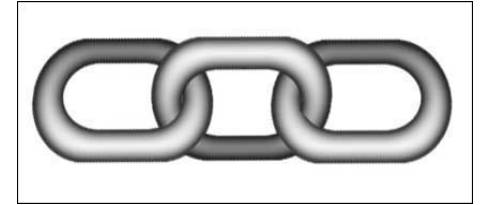
CLASS 101 – Connect

CONNECT

WORSHIP SERVICES:

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS:
